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GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING ABSTRACT:

Your Blind Abstract must be sent as an attachment in an email to conference@podiatry.asn.au. The body of the email should contain the following information:

1. Title,
2. Author,
3. Co-Authors,
4. Presenter,
5. Postal address,
6. Land line and mobile phone numbers.

Please ensure your name is not on the copy of the abstract.

- Abstracts are to be submitted in MS Word format
- 300 word limit and max 2 references (if relevant)
- Double line spacing
- Please include a brief introduction, results, conclusions and clinical applications.

(The purpose of the abstract is to provide the scientific committee with sufficient information to judge the merits of the project or presentation. If insufficient information is provided the submission will be rejected)

Clause 1:

When the abstract is accepted, the presenter must be registered or register for the conference within the fortnight following – otherwise the invitation to present will be withdrawn.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST:

Expressions of interest for workshop presentations must be emailed and should include:

1. The title
2. Presenter
3. Learning objectives
4. Postal address
5. Land line and mobile phone numbers
6. A copy of any handouts that will be presented of the workshop
7. Any relevant copyright information
8. A list of equipment required to run the workshop.
